Interested members of the general public may participate via Teams in the public portion of the meeting and will have an opportunity to provide public comments. Public comments are limited to 3 minutes per person, for up to 10 persons, with the total public comment period not to exceed 30 minutes. There is no charge to participate in the meeting.

**Advance registration is required for participants that wish to attend the meeting via Teams. Please be advised, virtual meeting participants may be limited to the first 100 registered participants. All participants' microphones will be muted upon joining the meeting but will be unmuted during the public comment period.

Please be advised that after the conclusion of the public comment period, it is possible that the Leadership Development and Philanthropy Committee may vote in the manner allowed by law to move into closed (non-public) session. Public participants will not be permitted to attend any closed portion of the meeting.

The agenda for the meeting will be posted on the Housing Authority of Cook County's website in advance of the meeting, in the manner provided by law.
